Within seconds, parents can see their baby and be informed on what's happening in real-time.

- ✓ **Camera System:** offers live-stream patient viewing to parents and family members anywhere, anytime. They can be across town or in another state, at work or handling childcare responsibilities at home.
- ✓ **Patient Connect:** allows for information sharing and engagement with care team through video, pictures and real-time texts
- ✓ **Safe, secure connection around the clock**
